Guwahati is the major gateway to the Seven Sisters! It has a rich cultural heritage going back to the Ahom Dynasty which governed the region for many centuries before the British occupation.

Located within the city is the Shakti temple of Goddess Kamakhya in Nilachal Hill, an important seat of Tantrik and Vajrayana Buddhism. The unique astrological temple Navagraha in Chitrachal Hill and Ummananda temple in the Peacock island in river Brahmaputra are places of mythological importance. The major places of interest are Shankardev Kalakhetra, Bhupen Hazarika Memorial, Assam State Zoo, and the River Cruise in the Brahmaputra.

For the purpose of tourism there are wildlife reserves like the Kaziranga National Park, Pobitora wildlife sanctuary, Manas National Park, Nameri National Park, Dibru-Saikhowa National Park etc. Majuli, the largest freshwater island in South Asia on the River Brahmaputra, is famous for its Vaishnavite Satras. The hill city of Shillong, the waterfalls of Cherrapunjee, the East Khasi Hills with the cleanest village in Asia Mawlynnong, and the unexplored beauty of Jayantia Hills within Meghalaya are major attractions at a doable distance from Guwahati.

Assam is world famous for its quality of tea as well as the natural beauty of the tea plantations. Enormously found mountain region, its greenery and pleasant climate make this location popular not only for its tea, but also for being a popular spot for enjoying eco-vacations.
